### GARDEN CLUB IS BLOSSOMING AN INTEREST IN GARDENING!

In 2018, [Greater Fair North, Parkdale/Union, 75 North](#) developed the [UrbanSpace](#) to be for their neighborhood, another fun, well-being, recreation, enrichment programming and community connecting. This space was designed to celebrate the North Omaha community and to find fellowship with friends old and new while creating opportunities for residents to network with professionals and discover new interests. This summer, the [No More Empty Pots \(NMEP\)](#) Community Education team is partnering with 75 North to teach neighborhood facilitator residents new skills and cultivate an interest in gardening! Meeting weekly, the Garden Club welcomes visitors and residents, regardless of their experience level with gardening, to participate. NMEP provides instruction and support in garden maintenance and best practices, and residents and visitors are able to engage with and care for their community garden beds, while deepening their relationships with one another. Kathy Barwell, 75 North Program Coordinator, said, "We've only done two sessions of garden club and residents are loving it! They're looking forward to working with our partners and learning new recipes this summer."
